ADDRESS BY EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Dear Educators, NE/CCE practitioners,

2020 has been an extraordinary year as the nation continues to grapple with the effects of Covid-19. Prime Minister Lee had referred to how our Pioneer Generation powered through the separation, our Merdeka Generation resolved to make the fledgling Singapore succeed against all odds and how it is now time for our current generation to step up to overcome this crisis. How Singapore overcomes this crisis, will define us and our current generation. This is the Crisis of our Generation. At this inflection point, the Singapore Discovery Centre too has endeavoured to play its part. Many of our colleagues participated in building the Community Care Facilities at Changi Exhibition Centre and a temporary dormitory at Kranji.

As school programmes and Learning Journeys (LJs) were affected by Covid-19, we pivoted to digital outreach to rally community support during these trying times. We digitalised the Total Defence Day 2020 programmes and incorporated Covid-19 messages. We also piloted a digital version of the Racial Harmony and National Day (RHND) programmes, which reached over 16,000 students from Primary to PSEs within a 1 month period. The National Education (NE) talks by our Commitment to Defence Ambassadors (C2DAs) were similarly adapted through online platforms.

Singapore Discovery Centre is committed to being at the forefront of pedagogical innovations to offer fun, engaging and cognitively stimulating programmes for students and educators. This includes venturing into new areas like role-playing, game-based learning, scenario-based learning and serious simulations. Enhancements are being made to our travelling exhibitions, gamification, outdoor trails and design of portable programmes that can be brought to schools. On the digital front, we will explore new forms of engagement, such as hosting large scale online events, virtual escape rooms, virtual amazing races, online social deduction games and online team building activities. By widening our strong network of



NE partners, we will further augment our MOE programmes with authentic primary sources.

Moving forward into 2021, sustainability will be an important focus area. As our society responds to the existential threat of climate change, we have introduced new and enhanced programmes within this booklet to raise awareness and inspire in students the will to contribute to sustainability causes. These programmes also feature what we have done at the Singapore Discovery Centre, such as the floating solar panels on the lake and urban farming projects. In fact, to continue to keep ourselves fresh and appealing, the Centre has undergone major rejuvenation works on the Permanent Exhibits Gallery and incorporated new attractions such as the Escape Room, Laser Tag arena and Makerspace.

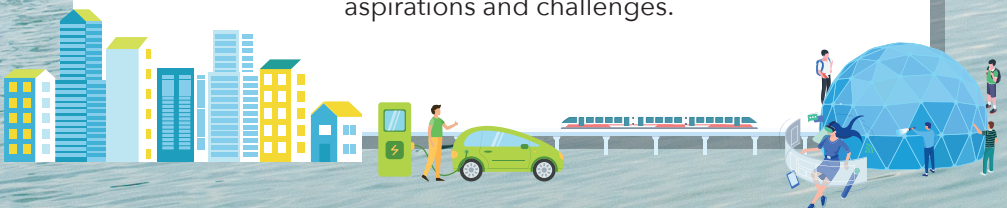

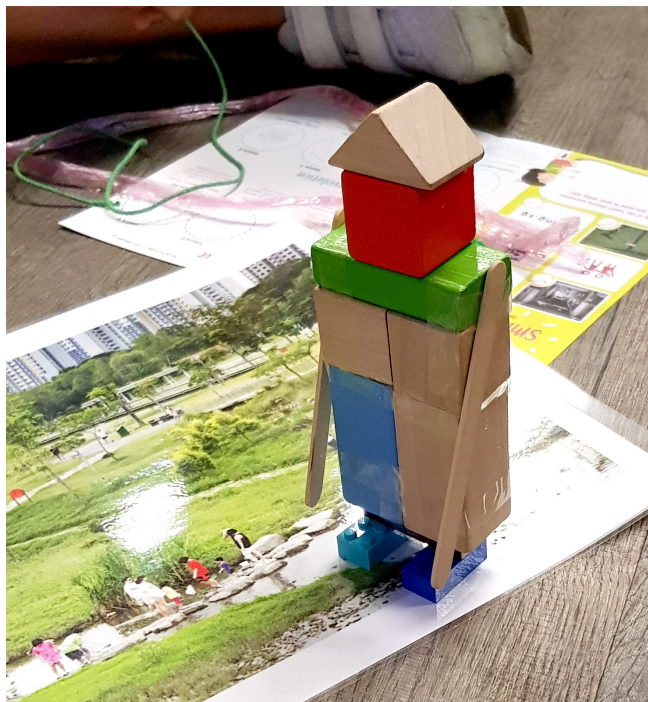

Students will discover more about Military Defence, one of the pillars of Total Defence. Through engaging and varied activities, students will understand the importance of the army and affirm their commitment to defend Singapore.

FIELD-CRAFT EXPERIENCE [1HR]

Students will engage in a variety of hands-on field craft activities such as basha pitching and camouflage. They will also learn to appreciate the role of the soldiers during jungle training.

SHORT FILM ENGAGEMENT [30MINS]

Through viewing of the short film, students will either gain insights on the importance of NS in Singapore and its early years or how Singapore battles against ongoing threats in terrorism.

1. Understanding how preserving peace and stability in Singapore always relies on everyone playing an active role and exercising Total Defence.
2. Uncover the meaning of *Staying United*, *Staying Alert* and *Staying Strong* in the SG-Secure Framework.

DURATION

2.5 hours (Inclusive of break)

RECOMMENDED LEVEL

Primary 4 – Primary 6

Students will engage in a game-based workshop to uncover the meaning of SG-Secure key messages of *Staying United*, *Staying Alert* and *Staying Strong*. Through the scenario-driven role-playing games, students come to realise the dangers of self-radicalisation and learn how citizens can all play an active role in anti-terrorism. The gameplay also highlights the importance of active citizenry in keeping Singapore safe and countering acts of terror by staying alert and practising the Run-Hide-Tell protocols.

Students will be introduced to the SG-Secure framework and uncover the meaning behind the key messages of *Staying United*, *Staying Alert* and *Staying Strong* through 2 interactive role-playing games. The first game highlights the dangers of self-radicalisation eliciting the importance of *Staying United*. The second game demonstrates how *Staying Alert* and *Staying Strong* through a terrorist attack scenario can make a difference and exemplify how citizens can play an active role in countering terrorism.



SG STORY GUIDED TOUR

1. Learn more about Singapore's early history and the challenges Singapore faced on her journey to independence.
2. Understand better how Singapore's "Can-Do" Spirit has helped us to be forward-looking, allowing all of us to play our part to build a First World Country.

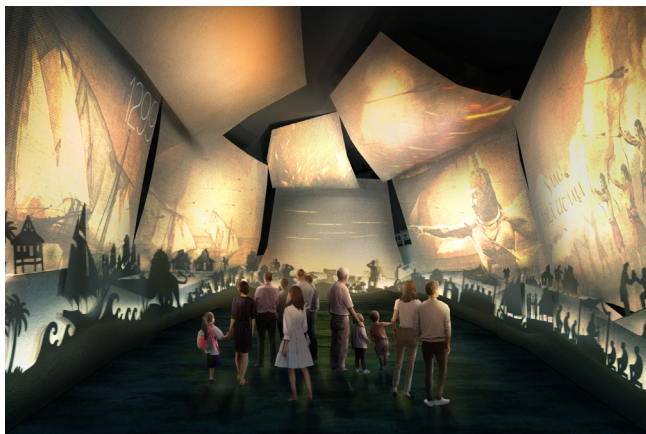

SINGAPORE DISCOVERY CENTRE GUIDED TOUR + NE FILM [1HR 30MINS]

SAFTI BUS TOUR [30MINS]

Ever wondered how Singapore manages to “fit and build everything” on our tiny island? This programme aims to provide a fun and interactive learning experience for students to understand the challenges faced by Singapore since our independence, and how we can continue to succeed by being innovative.

INTRODUCTION & CLASSROOM ACTIVITIES [1HR]

Explore the idea of population growth and changing needs versus land constraints. Learn how Singapore overcame housing challenges since her independence and how we can continue to overcome land constraint challenges.

GUIDED SOLAR PANEL TOUR [30MINS]

Develop a deeper understanding of how Singapore can overcome its land constraints with technology and innovation. Students will see how solar panels work with a tour of the Singapore Discovery Centre’s sustainability efforts e.g. energy output from solar panels, solar panels as a sustainable solution.

TOWN PLANNING SESSION & DEBRIEF [1HR 10MINS]

Students will then take on the role of town planners as they work to plan their ideal future neighbourhood. Through a hands-on exercise, they will learn and discover how every decision that they make will have an impact on the environment, people and land development.

INTRODUCTION [45MINS]

Understand and appreciate the importance and relevance of National Education (NE) and active citizenry and what it takes to be a NE Ambassador.

GUIDED TOUR @ SINGAPORE DISCOVERY CENTRE [2HRS 15MINS]

Understand how NE is put into practice through a guided tour of the Permanent Exhibits Gallery at the Singapore Discovery Centre (focusing on the Singapore Story).

PUBLIC SPEAKING SESSION AND DEBRIEF [3HRS]

Be exposed to the art of public speaking through experiential learning. Students will have an opportunity to use their newly acquired public speaking skills to deliver a presentation on the Singapore Story.

The fundamentals of how to be effective Gallery Docents - posture, gesturing, attire, body language, voice projection and story-telling - will be further explored.

WRITING A SPIEL [1H 45MINS]

Basic writing skills will be taught. Working in teams, students will develop their own spiels based on the Singapore Discovery Centre's Permanent Exhibits Gallery or their school's heritage / NE gallery.

GUIDING SESSION AND DEBRIEF [3HRS]

Be exposed to the art of guiding through experiential learning in an authentic environment. Students will have the opportunity to use their newly acquired skills by guiding their peers in the Singapore Discovery Centre's Permanent Exhibits Gallery or their own school's heritage / NE gallery.



NATIONAL EDUCATION (NE) AMBASSADOR: GALLERY DOCENT TRACK (GOLD)

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

1. Be a persuasive NE advocate.
2. Build self-confidence in order to be effective NE ambassadors.

SESSION 1 – BRIEFING SESSION AND INDIVIDUAL RESEARCH [1HR]

Revisit the fundamentals of being gallery docents and be assigned an exhibit or an area of focus. Students will be required to do individual research and write a spiel based on their exhibit/s.

SESSION 2 – PRE-ASSESSMENT INDIVIDUAL CONFERENCE [2HRS]

Students will receive additional support in the preparation for the Gold Badge final assessment. In this pre-assessment session (one-on-one conference), facilitators will provide feedback and check for content accuracy and NE relevance in the students' spiels.

SESSION 3 – FINAL ASSESSMENT GUIDING SESSION [3HRS]

Students will be individually assessed on their guiding of the assigned exhibit/s or area of focus.

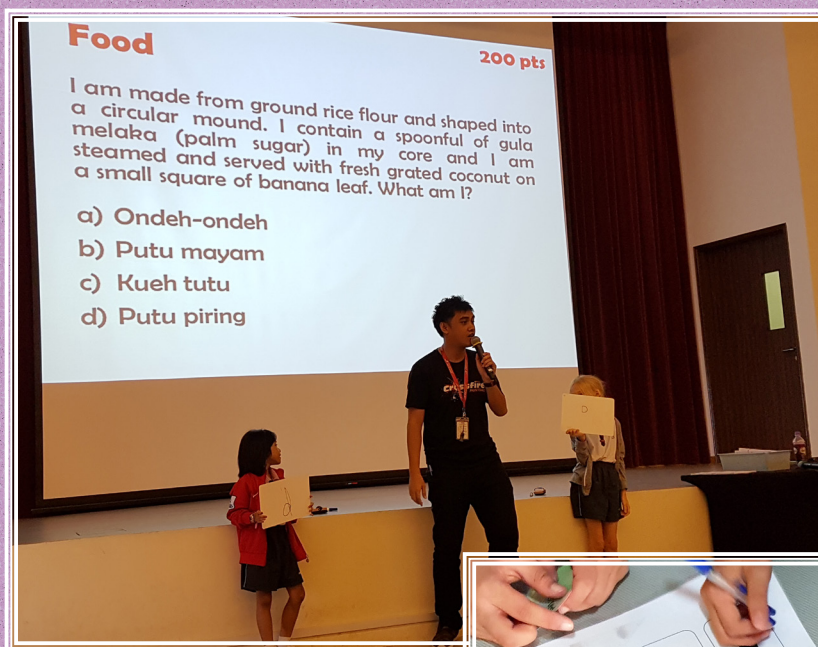

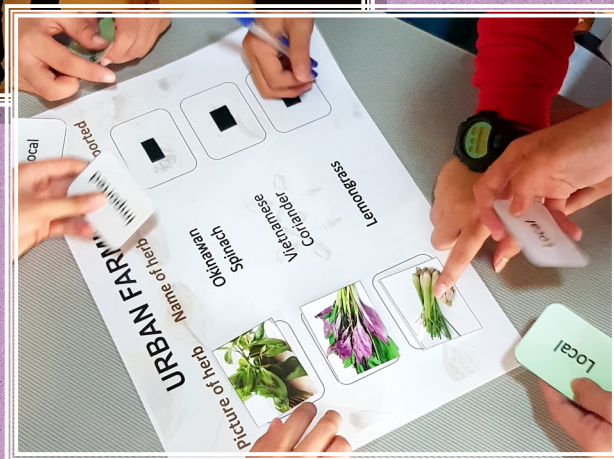
