ADDRESS BY EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Dear Educators, NE/CCE practitioners,

COVID-19 has changed our world in 2021. As a nation, we learnt to adapt to frequent adjustments to the Safe Management Measures that were calibrated to keep us safe. At the Singapore Discovery Centre, we too had to grapple with these requirements and be creative in overcoming constraints to tell the Singapore Story and engage schools, educators and students. Through the unstinting support of MOE and our wide network of NE partners, we were able to continue delivering on this mission. With rising vaccination rates and added precautions, we can now also look forward to the transition from pandemic to endemic as Singapore moves into a Covid resilient posture.

Singapore Discovery Centre is committed to be at the forefront of pedagogical innovations to offer fun, engaging and cognitively stimulating programmes. For Total Defence 2021, we experimented with a Digital Video Board Game format where students learned about resilience and optimism through the challenges faced by our main character as he goes about his job as a food delivery rider amidst COVID-19. The program was a success and engaged over 30,000 students. When it comes to new forms of engagement, another genre that has done well is the Virtual Escape Room, with in-house developed titles like "Faceless Danger" and "Final Boarding Call" that have engaged nearly 20,000 participants in online teambuilding sessions.

Indeed, we stepped up efforts to complement physical in-centre and outreach programmes to push the boundaries with new digital engagement products covering issues that matter to our nation. For the 2021 Digital School Assembly Programme, we addressed the recent incidents of racist behaviour and seized this learning moment to equip students with the skills and understanding to discuss issues of race in an open, meaningful and responsible manner. This digital program was done in a facilitated setting and included a series of 4 videos featuring social experiment with actors in the local context, that highlighted real-life scenarios. About 25,000 students across Primary, Secondary and PSEI levels were engaged through this program and it garnered positive feedback from the schools.



Another pressing concern is eco-sustainability, which is germane to our future generation. In line with strengthening our collective response to the existential threat of climate change, we pioneered and developed in-house programmes like the virtual "Oh What Farm!" which engages pre-schoolers and brings them on a virtual journey through our centre to explore food sources and help them understand ways to prevent food wastage. For secondary schools, we rolled out "Eco-Sustainability Champs", where students learn about eco-sustainability endeavours like the use of solar panels and urban gardening at the Singapore Discovery Centre.

Moving forward into 2022, we are pleased to present new and enhanced programmes that you will find in this booklet. These feature what we have done at the Singapore Discovery Centre, such as the newly completed Sandbox Gallery, which explores the complexities of contemporary Singapore. Under the five broad themes of Defence and Security, Unity, Enterprise, Fast Forward and The Interchange, the Sandbox delves into the pressing need for Singaporeans to grow our resolve, guard against fast-evolving threats, adapt to challenges and create opportunities for ourselves.

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
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ABOUT SINGAPORE DISCOVERY CENTRE






Students will engage in an in-centre game-based workshop to uncover the meaning of SGSecure key messages of *Staying United*, *Staying Alert* and *Staying Strong*. Through the scenario-driven role-playing games, students come to realise the dangers of self-radicalisation and learn how citizens can all play an active role in anti-terrorism.

CLASSROOM ACTIVITIES AND FILM

Students will be introduced to the SGSecure framework and uncover the meaning of key messages of *Staying United*, *Staying Alert* and *Staying Strong*. Students will have the opportunity to watch a film which highlights the dangers of self-radicalisation.

LASER TAG

Students will have the opportunity to engage in an exhilarating game of laser tag. The laser tag gameplay demonstrates how *Staying Alert* and *Staying Strong* through a terrorist attack scenario can make a difference and exemplify how citizens can play an active role in countering terrorism.






